## THE YEAR OF FAITH

This weekend we come to the last of the Homilies on the Nicene Creed, as we consider the words

*AND THE LIFE OF THE WORLD TO COME* - a part of the Creed which maybe has a special appropriateness, as we prepare to keep November, the Month of the Holy Souls, and the Solemnity of All Saints with which that month begins. And the month, too, in which the Year of Faith comes to an end, when, towards the end of the month, we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. In this Year of Faith, we have had the CAFÉ course, a year ago, on The Saints ; we have discussed one of

the Vatican II documents, during Lent ; and now, coming to a conclusion today, we have considered the essential teachings of the Church contained in the Nicene Creed. There is, of course, one further event – the Auction of Items and Promises in aid of three childrens' charities – which might be seen as a 'thank you' for what has gone before.
