The rules of the scheme concerning wives/husbands who are not tax payers themselves but are married to tax payers who do not attend church are quite clear. If your wife/husband is the tax payer and non-church attendee, and they are prepared to sign a gift aid declaration, as long as you have a joint bank account, we can claim tax relief on your offertory donations. Please remember that the tax reclaimed is tax you have already paid on income or savings, and the scheme will not cost you anything other than your normal offertory donation. # **YEAR OF FAITH**

Last Thursday the Year of Faith which the Holy Father has proclaimed got under way. Maybe some of you were able to get to the special Mass in the Cathedral? This is the first Sunday in the Year of Faith, and at Mass special cards will be blessed and distributed to you as you leave church. On the cards is printed the Apostles creed. It will be good to keep the card to hand to remind us that we are in this special time. It might be good to recite the Creed each day, to remind us of the central truths of our Catholic Faith. If we don't already know the Creed off by heart, it would be good to learn it.

One aim of the Year of Faith is to deepen our own personal faith. Both our knowledge and understanding of the Faith handed down to us, and our trust in Our Lord Jesus Christ and commitment to Him. The Café Course which begins a week on Tuesday is about this. The Saints, those great men and women of faith, will be helping us by their teaching and by their example.

The other aim of this Year of Faith is for us to help other people come to the Faith. And the Café Course has a part to play here too. It provides a special opportunity for us to INVITE people to come along with us. People often come to the Church by being INVITED AND BROUGHT. To this end, fliers about the Course are available today, and I want each one of you to one or maybe two with you, and give them to someone - either a lapsed Catholic known to you, or anyone else who is currently outside the Church. Hand over the flier with a smile and a warm invitation. If you are not prepared to do this, then please ask yourself what exactly you ARE planning to do to spread the good news of the Catholic Faith which has been entrusted to you, - not to be kept to yourself, but to share?
