**Looking ahead to Corpus Christi** Next Sunday is Pentecost, the following one is Holy Trinity (the Royal Jubilee Weekend), and then comes Corpus Christi Sunday, our great annual celebration of the Sacrament of Holy Communion. Three things will be happening :

1. When the Parish Council met last week, it was of a mind that we should once more have an all-night Vigil of Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, from the 6.0pm Mass on the Saturday until the 9.0am Mass on the Sunday. Will people be prepared to fill the rota for the all-night Watch? Will you? We decided to go forward in faith.

2. The Shrine at Walsingham is planning a Forty Hour Devotion on the Thursday, Friday, and Saturday before Corpus Christi, in preparation for the International Eucharistic Conference at Dublin in the week following Corpus Christi (at which Donal Hannon is going to represent us). The Programme for the Walsingham Forty Hour Devotion is available at the back of church.

3. Two years ago, there was a memorable Corpus Christi Procession at Oxburgh Hall, organized by the Deanery. This is going to happen again this year, at 3.0pm on Corpus Christi Sunday. More details later, but do put this in your diary.

Today we celebrate Our risen Lord’s return to the Father’s side in heaven, after the forty days during which he appeared to his disciples to assure them that he was indeed risen from the dead. There, he makes intercession for us at the heavenly Altar. But because he is God, God the Son, he also remains present with his people here on earth, their constant Companion and Friend.
