THE CLOSING OF THE YEAR OF FAITH

On Friday morning, a thousand children from Catholic schools within the diocese filled the Cathedral for a Mass to mark the ending of the Year of Faith. And then on Friday evening, a Candlelight Procession of the Blessed Sacrament made its way from the Castle to the Cathedral in Norwich, followed by a Vigil kept through the night. Representatives of our own parish took part in both events.

Then on Saturday morning, a joyful and crowded Mass was celebrated by the Bishop, to which we, like other parishes, sent a motor coach. At the end of that Mass, the Bishop blessed a candle for each parish in the diocese, which was received by a representative of the parish. Our representative was the Chairman of our Parish Pastoral Council, Donal Hannon.

And now today, that candle will be received by us all at each of the Masses. It stands, as the Paschal Candle does, for the light of the risen Christ. And it reminds us that we must be ready to go out to our own family and community with the Light of the Gospel. The Year of Faith has been but a preparation for our proclamation of the Faith. As we receive the Candle, we will say together:

CHRIST OUR KING,

YOU SHOW US THE PATH OF GOODNESS AND LOVE,

AND CALL US TO FOLLOW IN YOUR WAY. WHEN WE FAIL TO RESPOND TO YOUR CALL, FORGIVE US.

HELP US TO MAKE CHANGES TO OUR OWN LIVES, SO THAT WE MAY EMBODY OUR FAITH.

FILL US WITH COURAGE TO SPEAK OUT AND TAKE ACTION,

SO PEACE AND JUSTICE MAY REIGN ACROSS THE EARTH.

SUPPORT US AS WE BUILD A WORLD THAT REFLECTS YOUR KINGDOM,

A WORLD OF FAIRNESS AND FAITH. INSPIRE US TO BE WITNESSES TO THE LIGHT,

AND SO RENEW YOUR CHURCH, SO THAT ALL PEOPLE MAY KNOW THAT WE ARE YOUR DISCIPLES, AND THE LIGHT OF YOUR TRUTH MAY SHINE THROUGH US. AMEN
