THE YEAR OF FAITH

In the course of Homilies on the Nicene Creed, we last weekend completed the section of the Creed which speaks about Our Lord Jesus Christ. And so this week we move on to think about God the Holy Spirit. This section is worded

*I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT,
THE LORD, THE GIVER OF LIFE,
WHO PROCEEDS FROM THE FATHER AND
THE SON, WHO WITH THE FATHER AND THE
SON IS ADORED AND GLORIFIED,
WHO HAS SPOKEN THROUGH THE
PROPHETS.*

This will complete our reflection on the three Persons of the Holy Trinity, and I think it might be good for us all to ‘take a break’ before we look at the final clauses of the Creed. Accordingly, there will be ordinary liturgical homilies at the Masses next weekend, and then we will continue with the Creed the following week.

DECREE

**From the Congregation for Divine Worship and
the Discipline of the Sacraments**

‘..... The faithful in the Catholic Church have always shown devotion to St.Joseph and have solemnly & constantly honoured his memory as the most chaste spouse of the Mother of God and as the heavenly Patron of the universal Church. For this reason Blessed Pope John XXIII, in the days of the Most Holy Second Ecumenical Council of the Vatican, decreed that St.Joseph’s name be added to the ancient Roman Canon. In response to petitions, received from places throughout the world, that St.Joseph’s name now be added to the other Eucharistic Prayers, the Supreme Pontiff Benedict XVI, and now the supreme Pontiff Francis, deemed these petitions worthy of implementation and graciously approved them. In this the Pontiffs had before their eyes the full communion of the Saints, who, once pilgrims in this world, now lead us to Christ and unite us with him.

....Accordingly, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments is pleased to decree that the name of St.Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is henceforth to be added to Eucharistic Prayers II, III, and IV. Henceforth, after the name of the Blessed Virgin Mary, will follow the words ‘with Blessed Joseph, her Spouse’.

We will begin the implementation of the Decree here this weekend.
